

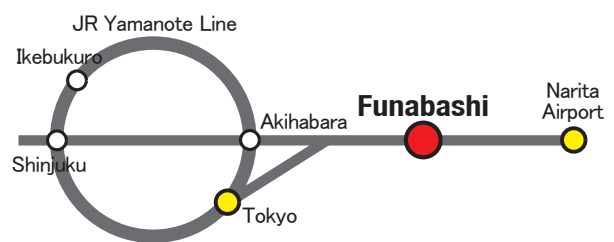
# 5 points in choosing a Japanese Language School

Whether you can realize your goals, purpose, hopes and dreams is most important!!!

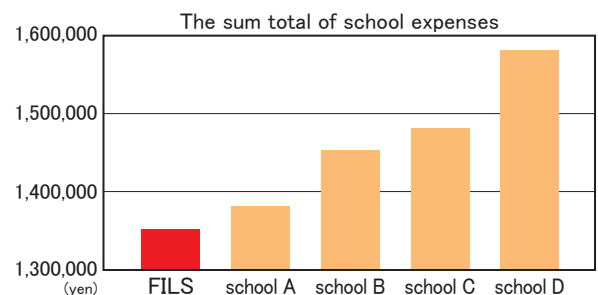
### 1 Don't choose on location alone!
